The intermediate workshop explores the basic principles of managing price risks in the Agri-Food Sector. It begins with the purpose, history, and development of trading. It explains the "A to Z" terminology and mechanics of trading. It provides a thorough study of hedging, basis, options and technical analysis with various commodity examples. The course ends with the development of a marketing plan.

It also introduces a set of advanced technical tools that measure volatility and oscillation and demonstrates their application in price risk management.
